Update on co-ordinated approach to identifying and supporting homeless people in Auckland

Update

NGO's have visited identified 'hot spots' of homeless people and MSD has attended clinics at the Auckland City Mission last week and 1 day this week.

On Tuesday 7 June, (the fifth occasion since 30 May) we provided a MSD staff presence at the Auckland City Mission evening clinic, this time between 4.30 and 6 pm as preferred by the Mission. Of the 80 engaging with the Mission, 3 people chose to engage with MSD. There were no mobile teams visiting locations last night as no NGO's were available to participate.

At this stage, mobile teams and attendance at Auckland City Mission will only continue until the end of this week.

Summary of engagement

A total of 479 people have been observed to date. Of these 464 were at the Auckland City Mission, 12 were in cars and 3 on the street at locations visited by NGO's.

To date (30 May to 7 June, inclusive):

- A total of 34 engagements with homeless people have occurred (voluntary).
 - All were single people.
- The total number of people observed at venues visited by NGOs is 15.
 - All were approached and only one person has chosen to engage with MSD, they were not homeless.
 - In the main, those in cars were working during the day.
- As a result of 5 nights visiting The Auckland City Mission, 19 people chose to engage.

- Of these, 9 social housing assessments have been booked (includes 1 re-booked), and a further 4 were already booked
