Instrument

1 Title

This instrument is the Seasonal Work Assistance Amendment 2021.

2 Commencement

This instrument comes into force on 26 October 2021.

3 Programme amended

This instrument amends the Seasonal Work Assistance Programme¹ (as established and approved on 7 July 2002).

4 Clause 4 amended (Interpretation)

In clause 4, replace the definition of 'seasonal horticultural worker' with the following:

seasonal worker means a person employed on a seasonal basis in a horticultural or viticultural industry.

5 Clause 6 amended (Seasonal work assistance)

In clause 6, delete clause 6(1)(a) and replace with: "(a) who is employed as a seasonal worker; and"

Explanatory Note

This note is not part of the instrument, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This instrument, which comes into force on 26 October 2021, amends the definition of seasonal work in the Interpretation clause to include viticulture, for the avoidance of doubt. This instrument also amends clause 6 to incorporate the revised definition of seasonal worker in the eligibility criteria.
