On 13 February 2019, you emailed the Ministry requesting, under the Official Information Act 1982, the following information:

Could I please request the following information for the 2017/18 financial year ending in June?

- 1. The number of children assisted by a Child Disability Allowance (and a breakdown of whether the caregivers were on main benefits, superannuation or neither).
- 2. The number of children for whom a Child Disability Allowance was granted (and a breakdown of whether the caregivers were on main benefits, superannuation or neither).
- 3. Could I also request the ethnicity breakdown for the Child Disability Allowance from 2000/01 to 2017/18 (just the data from June of each year would be great)?
- 4. Is it possible to get data on whether recipients (carers/parents) receive more than one Child Disability Allowance? So for example (numbers made up):

25,000 recipients (carers/parents) receive one Child Disability Allowance 5,000 recipients (carers/parents) receive two Child Disability Allowance 500 recipients (carers/parents) receive three Child Disability Allowance 200 recipients (carers/parents) receive four or more Child Disability Allowance

5. Can I also get the ethnicity breakdown of the Supported Living Payment for carers from 2015/16 to 2017/18 (just the data from June of each year would be great).

The Ministry works with clients to understand their circumstances, and the circumstances of their families to ensure that every individual is receiving their full and correct entitlements.

The online eligibility guide, launched in July 2018 helps individuals identify the types of financial assistance they may qualify for, then choose if they want to apply. This guide can be found on the Work and Income website here: www.workandincome.govt.nz/online-services/eligibility/index.html.

Enclosed are the following five tables which address your request:

- Table One shows the number of Child Disability Allowance recipients broken down by benefit received by the caregiver as at June 2018.
- Table Two shows the number of Child Disability Allowances granted, broken down by benefit received by the caregiver at the time of the grant, as at the end of June 2001 to 2018.
- Table Three shows the number of current Child Disability Allowance recipients, broken down by ethnicity of the caregiver, as at the end of June 2001 to June 2018.
- Table Four shows the number of current Child Disability Allowance caregivers that receive more than one Child Disability Allowance, broken down by the number of children as at the end of June 2001 to 2018.

• Table Five shows the number of current working age Supported Living Payment caregivers broken down by ethnicity, as at the end of June 2015 to 2018.

The principles and purposes of the Official Information Act 1982 under which you made your request are:

- to create greater openness and transparency about the plans, work and activities of the Government,
- to increase the ability of the public to participate in the making and administration of our laws and policies and
- to lead to greater accountability in the conduct of public affairs.

This Ministry fully supports those principles and purposes. The Ministry therefore intends to make the information contained in this letter and any attached documents available to the wider public shortly. The Ministry will do this by publishing this letter on the Ministry of Social Development's website. Table Four: Number of current Child Disability Allowance caregivers that receive more than one Child Disability Allowance, broken down by the number of children as at the end of June 2001 to 2018.

Notes for Tables One to Four:

- A CDA is paid to the principal caregiver for a child with a serious disability who needs constant care and attention, such as a child with physical, sensory, psychiatric or intellectual disability.
- A CDA is paid at a standard rate and is not income tested.
- A CDA can be paid to partners and primary clients in their own right.
- A client with a 'Non-beneficiary' benefit status is paid to an individual who is not currently in receipt of a main benefit, however is paid supplementary assistance.
- A client with a 'No benefit' status is not in receipt of a benefit, or receiving supplementary assistance, however may be in receipt of a CDA.
- Table Two: This represents a count of grants not individuals, as the same person may have been granted a CDA more than once. One caregiver may also be counted more than once if more than one child is granted a CDA.
- Tables Three and Five: It cannot be assumed that the ethnicity classification used to construct this table necessarily aligns neatly with the current Statistics New Zealand classification of ethnicity. Ethnicity details recorded in the Ministry's systems have been gathered under a variety of classification schemes as clients came into contact with the Ministry.
- Main Benefits exclude New Zealand Superannuation, Veterans Pension, Non-Beneficiary assistance, Orphan's Benefit and Unsupported Child's Benefit.
- In all cases of reporting benefit status of the caregiver, partners are included, , not just the primary recipients of benefits or pensions.
- Orphan's Benefit and Unsupported Child's Benefit are included in the 'No benefit' group.
