On 31 August 2021, you emailed the Ministry of Social Development (the Ministry) requesting, under the Official Information Act 1982 (the Act), the following information:

• The number of people receiving the Accommodation Supplement (quarterly or annual) for the last 5 years in the wellington region – a regional total and by territorial authority.

The Accommodation Supplement (AS) is a non-taxable benefit that provides assistance towards a client's accommodation costs. It is available for people who rent, board or own their own home and a person does not have to be receiving a benefit to qualify. It is calculated using a formula that takes into account geographical location, family size, accommodation costs, income and tenure type (renting, boarding or home ownership).
