On 18 May 2022, you emailed the Ministry of Social Development (the Ministry) requesting, under the Official Information Act 1982 (the Act), the following information:

• copies of all Cabinet Papers that were prepared by MSD on the proposed Retirement Villages legislation that are dated in 2002 and 2003.

On 16 June 2022, the Ministry advised you that more time was required to make a decision on your request, and that a decision would be with you on or before 14 July 2022. The reason for the extension was that your request is for a large quantity of information and it would take longer than the 20 working-day time limit to collate the material you have requested and assess whether any interest might be prejudiced by its release

The Ministry will do this by publishing this letter on the Ministry of Social Development's website. Your personal details will be deleted and the Ministry will not publish any information that would identify you as the person who requested the information.
