A brief update is provided below. A Working Group including representatives from MSD, IR, MBIE, and Treasury has been meeting weekly to co-ordinate and discuss monitoring and evaluation of the Wage Subsidy Scheme. An evaluation approach documenting key evaluation questions and plans for procurement of a process and outcome evaluation of the Scheme has been developed by the Working Group. A cross-agency Steering Group has been established to provide high-kevel oversight of the evaluation and to ensure that evaluation findings have influence within the participating agencies. The Steering Group includes General Managers and others with evaluation, optional for policy expertise from MSD, IR, MBIE, and Treasury. An initial Steering Group meeting was held on the 19th of May where a Terms of Reference for the Steering Group was discussed and feedback on key evaluation questions was provided. The next Steering Group meeting (scheduled for the 16th of June) will involve review of the evaluation approach developed by the Working Group. The Working Group has developed a preliminary intervention logic for the Wage Subsidy Scheme which will be shared with the Steering Group as well as the external supplier(s) procured to conduct the evaluation. 

Stocktake of review recommendations

Following the COVID-191 independent Continuous Review and Improvement Advisory Group's (CICRIAG) Report, DPMC has undertaken a stocktake of actions and improvements resulting from recommendations contained in external reviews of the COVID-19 response. The stocktake should provide assurance that the system is learning and adapting over time. The stocktake will include external audit or independent reviews dating back to March 2020, and will enable reflections and high-level analysis of the strengths and weaknesses of the response system. There are a large number of reviews, with many recommendations. Agencies are beginning to consolidate and track recommendations at an agency level and are sharing their lists to facilitate the collation and reduce duplication in reporting. DPMC is working closely with agencies, including MoH, MBIE and Customs to provide a complete system view for future reviews and changes. This work will be progressed in tranches to deliver value at pace.

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
