On 15 May 2022, you emailed the Ministry of Social Development (the Ministry) requesting, under the Official Information Act 1982 (the Act), the following information:

• Please provide the disability allowance income threshold for each year since 1989.

Disability Allowance (DA) provides non-taxable assistance to people who have on-going, additional costs because of a disability. You can find more information regarding the DA at the following link:

Please find attached an Excel Spreadsheet which includes **Table One**, which shows a list of the Disability Allowance income thresholds for the period, 1 April 1993 to 1 April 1998.

For DA income limits from 1989 to 1992, your request for this information is refused under section 18(e) of the Act as, despite reasonable efforts to locate it, this information cannot be found.

- to create greater openness and transparency about the plans, work and activities of the Government,
- to increase the ability of the public to participate in the making and administration of our laws and policies and
- to lead to greater accountability in the conduct of public affairs.
