On 20 May 2022, you contacted the Ministry of Social Development (the Ministry) requesting, under the Official Information Act 1982 (the Act), the following information:

• I'd like to get a regional breakdown of community services card holders, this would include Wairarapa of course but would allow me to compare to other regions as well.

On 20 June 2022, the Ministry emailed you to advise that more time was required to complete the consultations necessary to make a decision on your request.

The Community Services Card (CSC) is available to New Zealanders over the age of 16 on a low to middle income that meet the eligibility criteria. The card can be used to reduce the costs of a range of fees associated with healthcare and is administered on behalf of the Ministry of Health. Please see the **attached Excel spreadsheet** which contains one table, showing the number of Community Service Card holders broken down by Territorial Local Authority (TLA), as at 31 March 2022.

- to increase the ability of the public to participate in the making and administration of our laws and policies and
- to lead to greater accountability in the conduct of public affairs.
