On 2 May 2022, you emailed the Ministry of Social Development (the Ministry) requesting, under the Official Information Act 1982 (the Act), the following information:

• Details related to the expenditure of commissioned research the Ministry of Social Development has awarded to external organisations over the last three years. Specifically, I would like to know how many external commissioned research contracts there have been, who they went to, and how much it cost.

I refer you to **Appendix One**, enclosed which provides a list of projects contracted to external organisations in financial years 2021/2022, 2020/2021 and 2019/2020.
