## Tēnā koe

On 2 September 2022, your request was transferred from Housing and Urban Development to the Ministry of Social Development (the Ministry) requesting, under the Official Information Act 1982 (the Act), the following information:

• The number of motels used as emergency housing currently in the Howick area.

The Emergency Housing Special Needs Grant (EH SNG) is available to people who cannot remain in their usual place of residence, if any, and do not have access to other accommodation which is adequate for them or their family's needs. The Ministry pays EH SNGs directly to the accommodation supplier and assistance is generally granted for up to seven nights but can be extended depending on individual circumstances. There are four providers who have received an EH SNG for clients in Howick, as at the quarter ending June 2022. In the spirit of being helpful, these providers are as follows:

- Academy At Botany
- Airport Gold Star Motel
- Dannermora Motor Inn, and
- Essen Living

- to create greater openness and transparency about the plans, work and activities of the Government,
- to increase the ability of the public to participate in the making and administration of our laws and policies and
- to lead to greater accountability in the conduct of public affairs.

This Ministry fully supports those principles and purposes. The Ministry therefore intends to make the information contained in this letter and any attached documents available to the wider public. The Ministry will do this by publishing this letter and attachments on the Ministry's website. Your personal details will be deleted, and the Ministry will not publish any information that would identify you as the person who requested the information.
