On 23 November 2023, you emailed the Ministry of Social Development (the Ministry) requesting, under the Official Information Act 1982 (the Act), the following information:

I meant this the same as location, what Iwi/s do claimants identify with.

Am I able to also request a break-down of claims by ethnicity?

The Ministry's decision of 23 November 2023 to refuse your request for a breakdown of claims of abuse in State Care by Iwi remains unchanged.

As at 6 November 2023, Historic Claims has registered claims from 6,216 people (claimants). Of the 6,216 individual claimants there are a small number who have lodged multiple claims. This means the number of claimants may not match the total number of claims lodged with Historic Claims.

Please find enclosed in the **Appendix, Table One** showing the count of ethnicities declared by claimants. Some of this information is withheld under section 9(2)(a) of the Act in order to protect the privacy of natural persons. The need to protect the privacy of these individuals outweighs any public interest in this information.

I will be publishing this decision letter, with your personal details deleted, on the Ministry's website in due course.

Notes:

- There is no limit to the number of ethnicities a claimant can choose to declare.
- 868 claimants have declared two ethnicities.
- 26 claimants have declared three ethnicities.
- No claimants have declared more than three ethnicities.
- 659 claimants either did not declare their ethnicity or it was not obtained.
- A breakdown of claimants within mixed ethnic groups cannot be provided due to privacy as provided for under section 9(2)(a) of the Act.
