On 28 September 2023, you emailed the Ministry of Social Development (the Ministry) requesting, under the Official Information Act 1982 (the Act), the following information:

 Please advise whether you have any emergency housing suppliers registered in Taumarunui; if so, who are they and it respect of what properties?

You have requested a list of accommodation suppliers available in the Taumarunui area. The Ministry is unable to provide a list of Emergency Housing (EH) suppliers in a certain area as businesses may provide a registered address that is different to the physical address of their service (for example, a PO Box). The Ministry can instead provide a list of EH suppliers that have received an EH SNG on behalf of a client with a registered address in the Taumarunui area.

Please see the following **table** containing a list of registered suppliers where clients have paid for EH, using an EH Special Needs Grant (EH SNG), in the Ruapehu District during the period 1 January 2023 to 30 September 2023.
