## **Official Information Act request**

Thank you for your email of 25 January 2024, requesting information about financial assistance to assist ex-inmates into housing. I have considered your request under the Official Information Act 1982 (the Act).

The Ministry provides case-by-case assistance to individuals and offers a range of financial assistance depending on a person's circumstances.

Where someone has been in prison or remand for 31 days or more, they may be eligible for a Steps to Freedom grant, which can help with initial costs associated with getting set up in the community, including housing.
