## **Official Information Act request**

Thank you for your email of 19 January 2024, requesting information about Ministry advertising placed in Haere-roa, 90 Ilam Road, Christchurch.

I have considered your request under the Official Information Act 1982 (the Act).

The Ministry is aware of one Broken Heartline poster that is placed in the Foundry bar washrooms for the Love Better campaign. This advertising started from 4 September 2023 and is ongoing. The University of Canterbury's Student Association may be able to confirm the exact date the poster was put up in the washrooms.
