## **Official Information Act request**

On 6 December 2023, Waka Kotahi – the New Zealand Transport Agency transferred part of your request for information to the Ministry of Social Development as the agency best placed to provide the number of people who hold a Community Services Card (CSC) in the Far North District.

I have considered your request under the Official Information Act 1982.
