### **Official Information Act Request**

Thank you for your email of 19 December 2025, requesting information about how the Ministry of Social Development (the Ministry) determines eligibility, obligations and sanctions.

I have considered your request under the Official Information Act 1982 (the Act). Please find my decision on each part of your request set out separately below.

*I am requesting documents that define how MSD records are used to determine eligibility, obligations, or sanctions, and how those determinations persist over time.*

*Please provide documents that describe:*

- *how eligibility decisions are recorded*

Your request for this information is refused under section 18(e) of the Act as this document does not exist. However, I can confirm that the Ministry records eligibility decisions for assistance on individual client files within the Client Management System (CMS).

As the Ministry stated in the email sent to you on 26 January 2026, the following three bullet points of your request are quite vague, and it is unclear what information you are requesting. Therefore, the Ministry has interpreted these as laid out below.

- *whether determinations compound across time*

This bullet point has been interpreted to mean what effects sanctions have on Ministry clients and how different obligation failures compound over time. The following links contain information on sanctions and benefit obligations:

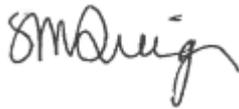
