Official Information Act request

Thank you for your email of 28 April 2026, which was forwarded to our office on 30 April 2026. You requested:

- *Please provide an anonymised list of all individual settlement offers made under the Common Payment Framework, broken down by each relevant redress agency. Please also advise any instances where the offer was also subsequently increased.*

In our correspondence dated 4 May 2026, you clarified that by the phrase “where the offer was also subsequently increased”, you were referring to instances where the original Common Payment Framework (CPF) offer has been increased by Ministry of Social Development (the Ministry) for any reason including following a challenge or reassessment.

I have considered your request under the Official Information Act 1982 (the Act). Please find my decision on your request set out below.
