


#### Supplementary benefits and hardship assistance
















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### Population proportion of 15-64 year olds receiving Jobseeker Support,










#### Jobseeker Support, by gender







### Special Needs Grants granted for food, by Regional Council








#### Jobseeker Support - Work Ready, by age groups


CIRP grants can subsequently be suspended or cancelled if the recipient gains employment or a grant was applied incorrectly. This means total grants over


