


A total of 163,383 students received student support, an increase of 0.7 percent compared to same period last year

146,994 students borrowed under the Student Loan (SL) Scheme




62,814 students received support under the Student Allowances (SA) Scheme




Long-term trends – January to December 2011 – 2021

The number of SL borrowers and amount borrowed both decreased




The proportion of SL borrowers who borrowed for course related costs decreased




Distribution of SL borrowers by type of education provider



The number of SA recipients and amount paid increased




Average Student Allowance paid




Distribution of SA recipients by type of allowances received
