Te Aorerekura Moemoea

People in Aotearoa New Zealand are thriving; their wellbeing is enhanced and sustained because they are safe and supported to live their lives free from family violence and sexual violence.

Te Huringa ō Te Ao Vision

Sustainable behaviour change for men to restore whānau wellbeing through locally led responses, reflective of the needs and aspirations of men, whānau and communities.

## Service Aspirations

Are key focus areas based on evidence that will act as a catalyst to elicit outcomes that are whānau led. Services delivered under Te Huringa ō Te Ao must align to these.















## Underpinning Principles

Essential elements that providers and services must commit to and demonstrate at all organisational levels to be effective in Te Huringa ō Te Ao.

Enacting Te Tiriti Practice

Actively address collusion (condoning, encouraging abuse) Whānau-led and whānau-centred

Continuous improvement, evaluation and reflective learning

Take an intersectional approach

Culturally, spiritually, and physically safe and responsive Skilled specialised workforce to effect change

Prioritise safety and wellbeing of whānau impacted by the violence Free and accessible services

Collaboration and integration with specialist services, Iwi and Hapū
